STRONG LEGISLATION, WEAK ENFORCEMENT

Legal Framework on Accessibility:

- * Urban Development Act and Regulation 4 on Accessible Built Environment: requirement to ensure accessibility of the environment; responsibility spread among local and national authorities, as well as private investors
- **Law on Integration of Disabled People**: separate chapter on accessibility of the built environment
- ❖ Anti-Discrimination Act: construction and maintenance of built environment impeding access of disabled persons to public places shall be considered direct discrimination.

Enforcement Mechanism

- Accessibility checks are not assigned to a special institution
- Sanctions are weak and not applied
- Fines are not paid
- Generally it

Anti-Discrimination Act

Anti-Discrimination Commission:

- Rule on whether actually discrimination is practiced
- just recommend to stop discrimination
- No compensations for the petitioner;
- Impose a fine the offender;

Discrimination in Education — the case of success

- 2005 a Coalition of NGOs filed a case against the Ministry of Education on the grounds of the Anti-Discrimination Act
- Ministry failed to prove that there are mechanisms and resources to accommodate the needs of disabled students in mainstream schools
- 2010 Regulation on Integrated Education of Children with Special Needs was passed
- 2017 provisions on inclusive education included in the Public Education Act

Vanya vs. Sofia Subway and Local Government

- Filed on 5th May 2005
- Against the Municipality and the Metropolitan Subway Operator
- Claimed compensation for damages incurred as a result of inaccessible subway in Sofia €2.000
- ▶ Submitted invoices for taxi transport



Case Won!

Final ruling dated 7th June 2007

Confirmed discrimination

► Awarded damages – €500



Issues Remained:

- Accessibility of the subway is 'on' and 'off';
- Enforcement mechanisms non-existent or toothless;
- Law level of awareness on the part of professionals and larger public;
- Disabled people not active;
- Most importantly:

NO RESPECT FOR THE LAW AND COURT RULINGS
